DEFINE THE LANDSCAPE OF CHERRY CREEK NORTH WITH YOUR PUBLIC ART CONTRIBUTION!

WHAT: Colorado artists take note: your chance has come to have work permanently on view in the prestigious Cherry Creek North (CCN) district!

As part of its diverse outreach and art education programs, the Cherry Creek Arts Festival is pleased to provide the first public artwork to the district through a program called Public Art in Cherry Creek (PACC). 2012 Installation

WHERE: The location of the Art & Garden site for this specific project is currently set for the planter box at 252 Steele St., Denver, CO 80206. (Please note that the location for the artwork will definitely be in a prominent place in CCN, though the precise location is subject to change.) For those unfamiliar with CCN, this is Denver's premier retail, dining, and mixed-use area, conveniently located just 5 minutes from downtown.

HOW MUCH: The budget allocated for this commission is \$20,000, which includes everything from structural engineering to transportation.

WHY: CCAF is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit corporation whose mission is to provide access to a broad array of arts experiences and support arts education in Colorado. Along with the arts festival itself, CCAF fulfills its year-round art education and outreach mission through programs including the Mobile Art Collection, Artist in Residence programs and the Janus Student Art Buying Program.
